IDC Track Specialization

- All the enrolled MA students at IDC and MIDAC majors are eligible to track specialization.
- Currently one track (Monitoring & Evaluation ME) is available, and two tracks (Development Finance DF, Environment & Sustainable Development ESD) will be introduced shortly.
- Track application can be made by the second week of the 3rd semester at the latest.
- Track candidates will take the minimum of 9 credits from the list of track courses suggested below.
- Track graduates will be awarded graduation certificate with the track name printed. (For instance, MA in International Development Cooperation with a special concentration in Monitoring and Evaluation)

 - Master's students must acquire 9 credits among CNEC major required courses in addition to the IDC required courses.
 - Doctoral students must acquire 12 credits among CNEC major required courses in addition to the IDC required courses.
 - All courses offered by the Graduate School of Energy Convergence are also accepted as major courses for GSP students majoring in CNEC.
